Burlingame, CA, March 6, 2011 – **Music at Kohl Mansion's** 28th Season continues on Sunday, March 20 at 7 pm, with the **Lydian String Quartet** and guest **Rhonda Rider**, cello, performing a program titled “Quintetssentials”, representing three centuries (18th, 19th and 20th) and a span of 150 years. The program includes Frank Martin’s rarely heard 1920 *Pavane couleur du temps*; Luigi Boccherini’s 1771 String Quintet in E Major, Op. 11, No. 5 (which boasts the well-known Minuet), and Franz Schubert’s String Quintet in C Major, Op. 163, written in 1828, two months before his death at age 31. The Lydian String Quartet, winner of the prestigious Naumburg Award for Chamber Music, is in residence at Brandeis University in Waltham, Mass. Joining the members for this evening of string quintets is founding member Rhonda Rider, cellist of the Triple Helix Piano Trio and presently on the faculty of the Boston Conservatory.
