the holiday season. The Aulos Ensemble takes its name from a Greek woodwind instrument, but the American group is connected to the spirit and style of the French baroque. Formed in 1973 by five Juilliard graduates, the ensemble has set the standard for vibrant spirited original instrument performance. The artistic intelligence of this ensemble, coupled with an uncompromising standard of excellence, has resulted in invitations from virtually all of America's major chamber music presenters. Aulos Ensemble is: flutist Christopher Krueger, oboist Marc Schachman, violinist Linda Quan, cellist Myron Lutzke, and harpsichordist Arthur Haas.
